## INTRODUCTION

**Congratulations on your purchase of a Rapid Spray Fire Fighting Unit** which is complete and ready to slip onto a ute, truck or trailer for immediate action when you need it most.



#### **WARNINGS**

- **1.** When mounting to any vehicle. Ensure that you have read the Vehicle Owner's Manual and that you comply with all weight restrictions specified by the vehicle manufacturer as overloading can cause injury or death.
- **2.** To ensure your own safety and that of your employees if applicable you must comply with all relevant environmental, work place health and safety legislation and codes of practice. In particular be aware of Rural Fire Service guidelines for safety when fighting fires or backburning.
- **3.** Select and wear appropriate Personal Protection Equipment in accordance with your own safe work practices.
- **4.** Improper or careless use of this unit can cause serious injury or death. Minors should never be allowed to use this unit. This unit should not be used when bystanders or animals are in the area. This unit should never be used while children are in the area.
- **5.** Never leave the unit unattended without turning off the engine and relieving the line pressure.
- **6.** You must be in good mental health to operate this unit and not be under the influence of alcohol or any drugs that could impair your vision, physical strength, dexterity, judgement, or other mental capacity.
- 7. All operators must be trained in safe use of this unit.

#### **OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS**

#### **BEFORE USE**

- 1. Check all hoses, connections and hose clamps to ensure that the unit has been delivered to you without transportation loss or damage.
- Before attempting any fire fighting with your new unit, operate it to familiarise yourself
  with its features and capabilities and to ensure that your unit has arrived in a safe
  working condition. Please contact your dealer immediately should anything appear to
  have been damaged.
- 3. Load the unit onto the back of a vehicle and fasten the unit securely to the vehicle by strapping or bolting it down. Ensure that the straps do not interfere with any hoses or connections. Do not place the straps over the pump or engine. Keep hoses and straps away from hot engine, exhaust and exhaust fumes.
- 4. Prepare the engine for use as per the engine manual supplied with your unit. Ensure that the correct quantity and type of oil is used when filling the engine.

#### **OPERATION**


- Fill tank from appropriate water source. For bottom filling see page 5 for instructions.
   Open ball valve on suction hose at bottom of tank. Start motor and allow to warm up.
   Bypass valve is fitted to top of pump and should be adjusted to allow bypass for warm up period.
- Unlock hose reel to allow hose to be pulled out. When using fire fighter adjust nozzle to desired spray pattern.
- Increase engine speed and adjust bypass to achieve desired flow rates. When job is
  finished turn engine off, rewind hose onto reel and lock reel to prevent unwinding.
  Close ball valve on suction hose.
- Please note this unit is designed for fire fighting and washdown or tree watering use and not for chemical spraying. Please consult the manufacturer for further information.

#### **DECONTAMINATION & MAINTENANCE**

- 1. After use the unit must be thoroughly decontaminated, inside and out, including pump, hoses and hand lance to prevent damage to the unit from corrosion or abrasion. As a guide follow the decontamination procedures below:
  - a. After use, the tank, pump, hand lance/nozzle and (if required) hose should be flushed by running it with clean water plus a recommended cleaning fluid.
- 2. When storing the unit, ensure that it is clean and dry and store in a well ventilated place.
- 3. If operating in areas where freezing occurs we recommend leaving anti-freeze in the pump, regulator/bypass valve and handgun/nozzle while not being used to prevent possibility of frost damage.



## **BOTTOM FILL KIT**

#### **CONTENTS**

- 6m x 38mm suction hose
- Camlock fittings
- Foot strainer

Aussie Pumps are designed for sucking water directly out of dams or water sources. The bottom fill kit is a quick, environmentally safe way of sucking up water to fill the water tank.

#### WARNINGS

Do not change hoses while engine and pump are operating. Observe all precautions listed in Fire Fighter Operator Manual. Be aware of hazards working near water sources particularly dams and rivers – slipping, falling, drowning and use safe work practices at all times.

#### **OPERATION / PROCEDURE**

1. Turn off engine.



**3.** Detach the suction hose from pump and attach to top outlet - refer to visual



- **5.** Place foot strainer and hose into water source ensure the strainer is in clean water free of sludge or debris.
- 7. Start engine and operate until tank is full. **NOTE:** Rapid Spray recommend removing / opening tank lid while filling tank.

2. Remove camlock cap from large outlet on pump - refer to visual.




**4.** Attach suction hose from bottom fill kit to suction point of pump - refer to visual.



- 6. Open ball valve at bottom of tank.
- 8. When tank is full engine off, close valve at bottom of tank and reverse steps 4 to 2 and unit is ready to use.
